

Women in Energy - Role Brief

The Women in Energy role within CIGRE Australia aims to promote gender diversity within our organisation to address the significant under-representation of women in the power sector and within CIGRE Australia.

The position is a volunteer role and is appointed by the CIGRE Australia Board. The initial term is for two years with the option for a term year extension.

Responsibilities of the Women in Energy representative

The Women in Energy representative will:

- Lead the Women in Energy initiatives and advocate for gender diversity within CIGRE Australia
- Contribute to Board strategic planning and decision-making processes and report to the Board from time to time
- Attend CIGRE's International Women in Energy bimonthly meetings (online) as the CIGRE Australia representative
- Foster collaboration and engagement among members and represent CIGRE Australia in relevant forums and events
