

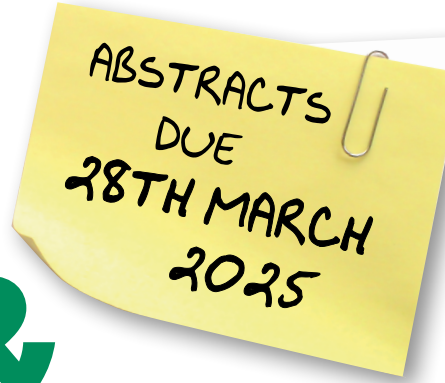

Following our successful International Symposium in Cairns in 2023, CIGRE Australia will again hold a suite of conferences, with the overarching theme **“Shaping the Power Systems of Tomorrow”**.

The joint event will include:

- > **The two-day 7th Conference on Integration of Distributed Energy Resources (CIDER25)**
- > **A three-day general conference focusing on the energy transition**

- > **A NextGen Power Professionals seminar by CIGRE Australia NGN (focusing on the professional development for young professionals)**

## **GENERAL CONFERENCE FOCUS AREAS**

## SUBMISSION OF SYNOPSES

CIGRE Australia invites power system experts, academics, engineers, policy makers and other stakeholders to lodge original synopses to: [www.conftool.pro/cigre-adelaide-2025](http://www.conftool.pro/cigre-adelaide-2025)

The synopses should:

- > Use the conference templates provided at the conference website: [www.cigreconference.com.au](http://www.cigreconference.com.au)
- > Identify if the abstract is for the general conference (and if so which focus area or areas are addressed), SEAPAC25 or CIDER25. It is acceptable to note more than one focus area.
- > Be lodged by 5pm (AEST) on Friday the 28th of March 2025.

Successful authors will be notified by 2 May 2025 and the final version of their presentations (and papers, for SEAPAC) will be required by 4 July 2025.

Note that the conference organisers may allocate presentations or papers to the general stream, CIDER or SEAPAC conferences if they are considered best placed there.

The final programme will be available on 1 August 2025. The programme is expected to include 10 sessions in the general conference. The programme will include all accepted presentations, and publication of received papers.

Presentations will nominally be 10-15 minutes long, but the duration of presentations may vary between the general conference, SEAPAC25 and CIDER25.

Additionally, invited papers and keynote presentations may be allocated more time at CIGRE Australia's sole discretion.

- Authors are required to attend the symposium to present their papers.
- Registration for the Conference is necessary.
- No discounts are provided to speakers.
- Registration entitles the speaker/delegate to attend the general stream, SEAPAC25 and CIDER25.

In submitting papers and/or presentations to CIGRE Australia authors assign the right to CIGRE Australia to deliver, distribute and market that content.
