

Win Complimentary Student Attendance to CIGRE Australia's CIGRE Cairns International Symposium 4 - 7 September 2023

CIGRE Australia are offering two (2) complimentary full registrations to attend the Cairns Symposium 4 -7 September 2023.

These registrations will include:

- Full Delegate registration to all sessions including SEAPAC and CIDER during the four days of the Symposium.
- Attendance at the opening ceremony, welcome reception, Women In Energy Breakfast, Young Engineers (NGN) forum, happy hour and Symposium Soiree.
- Five (5) nights accommodation (3-8 Sept) at the Mantra Cairns
- \$500 toward travel and other expenses

The award is open to any full time Tertiary Student who is resident in Australia and currently studying at an Australian University.

- 2. The student must be a member of the CIGRE Australia young Engineers group (NGN) membership is free and is available at this link https://ngn.org.au/join/ If not already members, the Applicant must apply prior to lodging an application.
- 3. The student must be able to attend the Symposium in Cairns Australia from 4 to 7th September 2023 (the award cannot be given as cash and the cash component will be reimbursed on completion of the post Symposium attendance summary)
- 4. The student should complete the proforma at this link, which includes a short statement (max 100 words) on why they would like to attend the Symposium.
- 5. Applications which meet the criteria will be placed into a draw and two entries drawn at random will be awarded the prize.
- Applications must reach the CIGRE Australia office no later than midnight 31 July 2023
 AEST. Submission details are contained in the survey link below. Late applications will
 not be accepted.

Note: The recipients of the award must attend the Symposium in full including all NGN events and the evening networking function.

Following the Symposium, award recipients must submit a short commentary (200 words) on their experiences at the Symposium which will be published online and in CIGRE's In The Loop newsletter. (The award recipients will be reimbursed the cash component of the award upon receipt of the post Symposium short commentary/article)

This is a great opportunity to attend an international power conference without leaving Australia.

We have eleven (11) of the sixteen (16) Global Study committees attending and over 250 technical papers being presented, plus the CIDER (Conference on the Integration of Distributed Energy Resources) and SEAPAC (South East Asia Protection Automation and Control) conferences being run conjointly with the Symposium.

We are anticipating over 700 delegates from across the breadth of the power industry, so this presents a great opportunity to hear and learn of what is happening in the Energy Transition space and to begin to establish your industry contacts which will last your career.
