



## **Women in Energy - Role Brief**

The Women in Energy role within CIGRE Australia aims to promote gender diversity within our organisation to address the significant under-representation of women in the power sector and within CIGRE Australia.

The position is a volunteer role and is appointed by the CIGRE Australia Board. The initial term is for two years with the option for a two-year extension.

### **Responsibilities of the Women in Energy representative**

The Women in Energy representative will:

- Lead the Women in Energy initiatives and advocate for gender diversity within CIGRE Australia
- Contribute to Board strategic planning and decision-making processes and report to the Board from time to time
- Attend CIGRE's International Women in Energy bimonthly meetings (online) as the CIGRE Australia representative
- Foster collaboration and engagement among members and represent CIGRE Australia in relevant forums and events
- Subject to CIGRE Australia Board approval, be invited to attend the CIGRE Paris Session in August 2026 as the Australian Women in Energy representative.

The role is open to Individual Members and employees of Collective Members.
